

1558 - HUMPHREY CHAPPELL WILL

In the name of God amen in the 24th day of August in the year of our Lord God 1558
I Humfrey Chappell of the parish of Chittlehampton in this wise doe make my
Testament First I bequeath my soule to almighty god and my boddie to the holly
ground First I give and bequeath to my father in law 40 shillings. Item to every one of
my brothers 5 pounds apeece pd [by] my brother George. Item to my sister Jakeyt 10
pounds. Item to Christofer Chappell 40 shillings. Item to Elizabeth Chappell of Exeter
40 shillings. Item to Thomasyn the daughter in law to William Chappell of Exeter 20
shillings. Item to Johan the servant unto the said William X shillings and X pence.
Item to every servant in my father in laws house 5 shillings apeece. Item to every
manchild of my uncle John Chappells house X shillings and X pence. Item to every
poore householder dwelling in Chittlehampton 12 pence apeece. Item to John Lake my
godsonne 12 pence. Item to the high altar 12 pence. Item to [possibly] George
Chappell _ X pence. Item I give for forgotten tithes 6 shillings and 8 pence. Item to
my uncle William the Clerk 6 shillings and 8 pence. The rest of my goods I give and
bequeath to William Chappell my brother of Exeter whom I make my sole executor
whereof being witnessed Robert Bulpayne clerk vicar John Chappell of Fulbrook
Bartholomew Braley and George Chappell.
