fifth and fourth Defender of the faith etc. I John Gappell the elder of the Citie of Exeter
Merchant and one of the Aldermen of the said Citie beinge aged and sound of mynde and in my
perfect remembrance thanks be unto God made and ordayne the said my present testament declaringe
my last will in manner and forme followinge, first I commend my soule in the most mercifull hands of God
and my bodye to Christian buriall, Item I give and bequeath unto the poor people of the parish of Gylt
Hampton in the County of Devon the summe of lawfull money of Englande, And to the poor people
of the parish of Alington in the said County of Devon the summe of lawfull money of like money to be distributed
amongst the said poor people of the said parishes by the discretion of the wardens and free men of the said
parishes, Item I give and bequeath to the Mayor Bayliffes and Commonalties of the Citie of Exeter
the summe of lawfull money of Englande, And to the poor people of the parishes of the said Citie and County
to be distributed amongst the said poor people of everye the said parishes within the said Citie and County
of the said Citie, Item I give and bequeath to my sonne Henry Gappell my best silke of silver gilted
silver spoons and one of my hundredes of silver gilted, To my sonne Daryng Gappell my best
silver salted gilted with silver spoons and a silver Bole gilted, To my daughter Willmote Wood
my best broad Bole of silver gilt, To my youngest sonne Richard Gappell my round silver salted and
silver spoons, But nevertheless I will that the same my wife and executorye of the said my testament shall
have the use and occupation of all the said plate bequeathed to my said daughter as afore said dmyng the
life and not to be delivered untill after her decease or before at her will and pleasure, Item I give and
bequeath to my sonne youngest sonne Richard Gappell the summe of one hundred and fiftie pounds of
lawfull money of Englande to be paid him at the age of twentye yeres, and untill the age of twentye yeres
my executorye to paye the said Richard Gappell the summe of twentye pounds yearlye quarterlye by even portions
To my said sonne Daryng Gappell one hundred pounds of lawfull money And to my sonne Henry
one hundred pounds of lawfull English money, To be paid them the said Daryng and Henry
by my executorye within one yere next after my decease, And unto everye of my good children
a part, Item I devise will and bequeath unto my said sonne Henry Gappell and Daryng Gappell
an Annuall Rent of the summe of lawfull money of Englande to be assigned and gonne
fourthlye out of all the best messuages landes and tenementes with their appurtenances lyinge and
beinge in Alington afore said in the said County of Devon which I the said John Gappell
have had and hold by severall demyses and leases by deedes indented thereto made and
granted by Sir William Comtrey Knight for diverse severall termes of yeres nexte and cominge

the xxviii daye of December in the ninth
yeare of the reigne of our soveraigne Lord James by the grace of God now Kinge of England &c And in
the xxviii daye of our Lord one thousand six hundred and eleven I Matzei Abraham of the parish of St
Peter in Maldon in the County of Essex by myn hande and seale in bodye yett of
good and perfect memorye testified by God knowynge that all men by nature are borne to die. For thefore
I have published and declared this my last will and Testament in writinge in maner and forme followinge
that is to witte. First and principally I comend my soule into the handes of Almighty God that blessed
Comite the ffather the sonne and the Holy Ghost in whose name I am baptized assuredly belemyng that
all my synnes of the vnspeakable love and mercy of God my lord and onelye saviour Jesus Christ by
and through his precious merittes sufferinge and passyon are remitted and done away and in his ransome
dunt and assurance I rest and waite wth patient affe this vnspeakable life ende to be made perfect
of his endless blessednes, And my bodye I comitt to be buried at the discretion of the executors of this
my last will and Testament here by me named, And as touching the worldly goods possessions and
benefittes wth the Lord God of his boundles goodnes hath bestowed on me for this mortall life my mynde
and will is to be disposed as followeth. First I doe give and bequeath unto Dorothy my welbelovyd wyffe

to rent or be made and raysted of and wyffe such sale or sales theye of I will to be employed by them for
and forward the payment of my debtes and spiriualle legacies and portions of money by this my Testament
given and bequeathed and theye of wyffe upon my executors to be paid and all the residue and ceteris of
the same of money of and wyffe such sales aforesaid made I will to rent and to be paid unto the said
Dorothy my wyffe for and forward parte of payment of the ffather by me remitted wth wyffe or more

price of my sister Dymasent (last decessed) or by his executors for the best price and to the most

discharge and satisfie unto the said Dorothy my wyffe the of the parte and residue of the said portion
